75% of all businesses are sole traders (SOLO)

95% of all businesses employ less than 10 people (MICRO)

99.9% of all businesses employ under 50 people (SME)

250% - increase in social following (8895 end June)


SiGNAL spearheaded a popular digital campaign to coordinate local 3D printers and delivered 1000 x 3D printed Visors to the NHS

10 great coworking spaces in Hampshire

1. SIGNAL, Bordon

SIGNAL is one of Hampshire's newest coworking spaces, providing local business owners, freelancers and entrepreneurs with an important hub in Bordon. We offer a free coworking space with desk and meeting room hire available too. As well our inspiring coworking and office spaces, we also have maker rooms, techie rooms and a wellness room for different users. Our focus is not just on providing people with somewhere to work, but also somewhere to grow their businesses, whether they're a tech start up, maker, consultant, therapist or any other small business. We're big on education, collaboration and innovation, and offer a variety of business support as well as a desk.

2. BASE Bordon Innovation Centre

Another new coworking space also in Bordon is BASE at the Bordon Innovation Centre. This space is aimed at start-ups, SMEs, and high-growth businesses and has a choice of monthly desk hire in a shared office, or you can work from the business lounge for a daily fee. BASE also has serviced office spaces to let as well as a variety of corporate meeting rooms. Monthly desk hire starts at £180 plm, and business jounce access is £10 p/d. More details here.

3. Innovation Space, Portsmouth

More shared office and coworking spaces are available at the Innovation Space in Portsmouth. Here you can hire a hot desk for up to 10 days per month, rent a full time dedicated desk or alternatively your own private office. Business support is also available from this location. 



Know your vision and set clear goals



Your business is a matrix of relationships with you at its centre



There are no longer any physical barriers to collaboration with anyone in the world

Ways to Collaborate if you are a Small Business or Sole Trader

Collaboration is key if you are a small business as it can amplify your reach, plug gaps in your resources and increase your resistance to threats.

Here are some ways that you might consider collaborating with other businesses in your space for mutual benefit

Preparation:

- Be clear about your goals articulate them somewhere, preferably in a vision and mission statement on your website and social platforms where people can easily see and understand them
- Make a list of influencers and people you would like to get to know people that will help you combat weaknesses and who can help you move closely towards your goals

Then try any of the following quick wins:

- Comment on their posts
- Respond to their output (retweet, share)
- Compile a directory post where you list some of them and their attributes in a blog, then tell them about it
- Find them on Linked in and Twitter
- Look at what hashtags they use (are they attending any Twitter hours? You can easily see in their feed) and what groups they are in join the group if you can.
- Find out what online networking they do and join in
- Ask them for advice

If you have a bit more time to invest consider the following collaborations

- Offer to co host an online networking event, or a twitter hour
- Start a facebook group the people you have identified
- Offer to write a guest blog for them
- Offer to speak at their events
- Interview them for a blog or podcast
- Invite them to collaborate with you on a project

If its skills you are short of consider the following

- Outsourcing to a company like People Per Hour
- Delegating to a professional support person, a VA or a bookkeeper
- And of course, consider hiring in some talent and always choose people who can do things you cant do!
